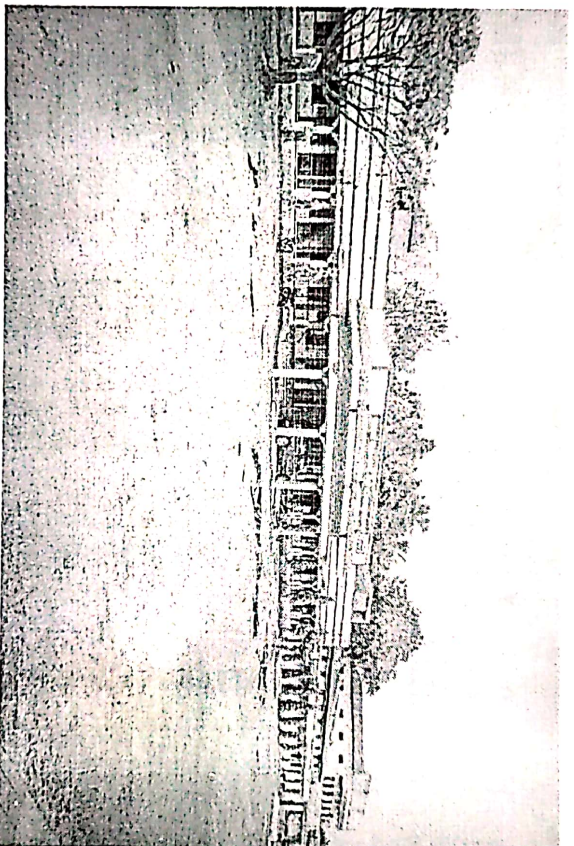

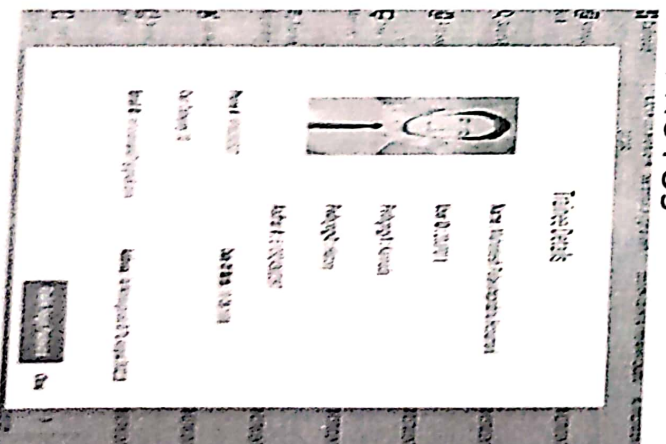
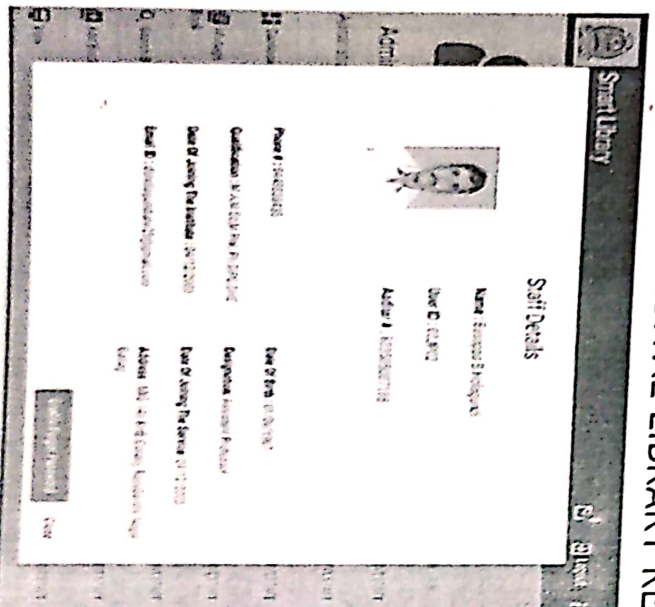

LIBRARY WORK

The JP College of Education library is Fully Computerized and Bar-coded. There is use of "LIBMAN" librarymanagement since 2004, upgraded to the cloud version software with online license in 2021. Circulation of the library books stocks items, including issue and return of the book by student and staff, is also entirely computerized. Library also has mobile based OPAC system (M-OPAC) which can be accessed by the users from anywhere on their mobile phones. The library has aboutbooks, including a collection of Reference Books for Competitive examinations like KJET/CET/UPSC/MPSC/NET-SET/BANKING etc. Our Reading room is the one of the biggest in central India with a sitting capacity of about two hundred students. There is an Institutional Repository created using open access digital library software GSDL, which has collection of old question paper, Syllabus, E-Contents created by staff, e-books etc. There is a UGC Network Resource Centre for accessing internet for staff and students. Reprography service is available. "AKSHAR Forum", a book review platform has been established, with several activities aimed to inculcate reading habit in students, instill critical thinking and to enhance presentation skills.

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Case Study

Introduction:

A case study is a in-depth study of one person, group/event. In a case study nearly every aspect of subject's life and history is analysed to seek pattern and causes of behaviour.

Case study can be used in variety of field including psychology, medicine, Education, anthropology, Political science & social work. -A hope that learning gained from studying one case can be generalized to many others.

Case study tend to be highly subjective & it is some-times difficult to generalize result to a larger population. while case study focus on a single individual or group. They follow a format that is similar to other types of psychology writing.

Meaning of Case Study.

- Case studies are in-depth investigations of a single person, group, event or community.
- Typically data are gathered from a variety of source and by using several different method.
- The case study research method originated in clinical medicine.
- In psychology, case studies are often confined to the study of a particular individual.

Definitions:

- John Gearing - The case study approach as an initiative study of single unit or a small no. of units. for a purpose of understanding a larger class of similar unit.
- Collins dictionary - A case study is a written account that gives detailed information about a person / group of things and their development over a period of time.
- Press academics - A case study is a descriptive and exploratory analysis of a person, group or event.

Importance of Case Study.

- 1] A major advantage of teaching with case studies is that the students are actively engaged in figuring out the principles by abstracting from the examples.
- * It develops their skills in Problem Solving.
- * Analytical tools, quantitative and qualitative, depending on the case.
- * Decision making in complex situations.
- * Coping with ambiguity.
- 2] The actual use of a case as a means of learning depending deeply on the class participation. Through exchange and constructive discussion, students will be able to build analytical skills and gain conceptual understanding.
- 3] It also encourages rigorous thinking and helps students improve their communication skill.
- 4] A case study can provide the necessary platform for students to communicate and collaborate about a situation that concerns a certain group.

Steps of Case Study

- * Determine and define research questions.
- * Select cases and determine data collection and analysis technique.
- * Preparation for data collection.
- * Collection of data in the field.
- * Evaluate and analyse data.
- * Prepare the report.

1] Determine and define research questions:

→ The researcher establishes the focus of the study by asking questions about the situation or problem being studied and determining a purpose for the study. The Object of research in a study may often be,

- (a) A programme or entity. a person. a group of people
Each object is likely to be intrinsically linked to issues.

3] Select cases and determine data collection and analysis techniques.

- The researcher determines which approaches will be used in the selection of single / multiple real life cases to examine in depth and ~~selection~~ which instrument & approaches to data collection will be used.

3] Collection of data in field.

- The researcher must collect & store multiple sources of evidence comprehensively and systematically in formats that can be referenced & classified so that convergent line of inquiry & patterns can be discovered.

3] Evaluate and analyse the data.

- The researcher examines the raw data using many interpretations to find link between the search object & the result with reference to the original search questions.

3] Prepare the report.

Example of case study report the data in a way that transform a complex issues into one that can be understood allowing the reader to question & examine the study and come to an independent understanding of the researcher.
